AISATS upgrades ground support system

MUMBAI: Air India SATS Airport Services Pvt. Ltd. (AISATS), an equal joint venture of Air India and SATS, has announced an additional investment of Rs.57 crore in new Ground Support Equipment (GSE) in India. The fresh investment has been made at the Delhi airport. This is part of the company's investment of Rs.85 crore made in GSE during the past one year. Since its incorporation five years ago, the company has invested more than Rs.160 crore in GSE. It provides service at Bengaluru, Delhi, Hyderabad, Mangaluru and Trivandrum airports.
