

AISATS BLR honoured at Pinnacle Awards 2015 !

AISATS was honoured recently with 2 awards at the 2nd edition of the Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru (KIAB) Pinnacle Awards 2015 – a platform to recognise excellence and collaboration within the airport community.

The “**Excellence in Sustainable Practices - Aviation Services**” award was in recognition of the efforts made towards waste management, including the use of Biodiesel leading to the reduction in carbon emissions and use of fossil fuels, and the recycling/re-use of materials such as plastic sheets, waste wood and damaged wooden skids. The 2nd award, the “**Transformational Tech Idea**” award, was in recognition of the implementations at AISATS including the adopting of the “Make in India” concept for the maintenance of its Ground Support Equipment (GSE) by re-engineering and developing designs in-house to suit local requirements instead of depending on expensive imports. AISATS also introduced a mobile app to enable direct input of services rendered at the ramp on a real-time basis, removing the need for additional back-end manual data entry, thereby improving efficiency while reducing potential errors.
